# Cell Phone & Mobile Device Policy Cornerstone Christian School

In an effort to minimize distractions in the classroom and on campus, students at Cornerstone Christian School may not use any type of cellular phone or communication device during the school day. While these items are a growing part of our culture, they must be turned off during the regular school hours (7:50 a.m. – 2:50 p.m.) and kept in the locker. The following consequences will be carried out if a student is found to be using a cell phone or personal communication device, or if the device is activated at any point during academic school hours, or if the device is taken from the locker before 2:50 p.m.

- 1. First Offense: The device will be taken up by the teacher or administrator and held in the main office for the remainder of that school day. The student may retrieve the device before leaving campus on the day of the infraction. A parent will be notified of the situation via email and one demerit will be issued.
- 2. Second Offense: The device will be taken up by the teacher or administrator and held in the main office for the remainder of the school day. The student may retrieve the device before leaving campus on the day of the infraction. The student will then be required to check the device into the main office upon arrival each morning for the following five school days. The device will be available for that student to pick up prior to leaving at the end of each of those days. If for whatever reason, the student fails to check their device in during the five-day period, an additional day will be added to the initial consequence. Three demerits will be issued for the second offense.
- 3. Third Offense: The phone will be taken up and the school secretary will immediately notify the parents. The student will then be banned from bringing any cell phone or communication device to school. A third offense will be seen as no less than a Category II offense with a 5 demerit penalty.

#### Acceptable Use Policy:

Students are responsible for using common sense, ethical standards, and good manners when online or texting. "Online" includes email, instant messaging, social networks, blogs, personal web pages, and other similar sites accessed through the Internet. Students who post or send inappropriate material will face disciplinary action, including probation, suspension, or expulsion.

Unacceptable communication is forbidden at all times and includes:

- profane, lewd, obscene, vulgar, rude language, or any suggestive words, symbols or initials
- statements to or about another student or teacher that may be interpreted as:
  - 1. harassing (persistently acting in a manner that distresses or annoys another person).
  - 2. sexually provocative
  - 3. threatening or disrespectful
- knowingly post false or defamatory information about a person or organization.
   If you are told by another person to stop sending messages, you must stop.

   Students should report all such incidents of misconduct to a teacher or parent immediately.

Social Networking Sites- Social networking sites such as Facebook, Twitter, etc. are not allowed at school. However, the school realizes many students have access to these sites outside of school. Students are reminded that regardless of where their posting originates, any text, photographs or videos they put on these sites or similar sites which would be derogatory to the school, their Christian testimony, or the school community, or threaten, demean, or bully faculty or other students, is strictly prohibited.

Website Postings- Due to the public access and nature of a web domain, students must only post items that are in line with the moral values of the Word of God.

#### Plagarism and Inappropriate Access to Material

Students must not plagiarize works that they find on the Internet. Plagiarism is taking the ideas or writings of others and presenting them as if they were yours. Internet sources must be cited following MLA guidelines. Students should not access material that is profune or obscene (i.e., pomography), that advocates illegal acts, or that advocates violence or discrimination towards other people (hate literature).

Student Declaration of Appropriate Use:

- I understand that I continuously represent Christ Jesus and Cornerstone
   Christian School whenever and wherever I use e-mail, the Internet, or send text
   messages.
- I will not annoy, hinder, or harass others with offensive, obscene, abusive, or threatening language in any electronic communication.
- I will not access, download, store, or print obscene or pornographic material.
- I will not plagiarize works that I find on the Internet. (Plagiarism is taking the ideas or writings of others and presenting them as if they were yours.)
- I will follow the posted and/or handbook rules regarding the internet and texting.
- If I violate any of these rules or knowingly enable others to violate these rules, I
  will be subject to disciplinary actions including expulsion.

### Penalty Procedure for Inappropriate Use:

Notice # 1. Student is advised, warned, and asked to remove the posting. Warning is posted on student's record. Note: Any extreme posting (nudity, profanity, etc.) may result in a more severe initial penalty.

Notice # 2. Student is counseled. Demerits are issued based on the seventy of the posted material. Material is removed.
Notice # 3. Student is banned from all social media posting. Demerits are issued beginning with Class II notation for "direct disobedience."
Any further recurrence in the same area may result in suspension or expulsion of the student and possible denial of future enrollment.

### Parent's Code Cornerstone Christian School

- 1. I have read and understand the parent/student handbook and agree to the regulations therein.
- 2. I hereby pledge to pay my financial obligations to the school on the date required, and understand that late fees will be assessed when payment has not been made by the 5th of the month. In the event a problem does arise, I will immediately contact the school business office.
- 3. I understand that my student's grades, or any other school records, will not be released or transferred unless my school bill is paid in full.
- 4. I understand that the teacher has full discretion, subject to the approval of the administrator, for the grade placement of my child.
- 5. I authorize this school to employ such discipline as it deems wise and expedient for the training of my child. This includes the use of corporal punishment in those instances where the handbook states, or in cases where it is deemed necessary.
- 6. I further agree to hold the school and its agents harmless of any liability to my child, or any guardian or parent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child. Should legal action, for any reason, be taken against Cornerstone or any employee or agent thereof, on my child's behalf, and the school or its agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay the attorney's fee, court fees, damages, or other costs that Cornerstone or its agents should incur to defend itself against such action.
- 7. I also understand that my participation is needed in educating my young person and will check his/her work regularly to ensure that the work required is done.
- 8. I also understand that unless my child is present he/she cannot receive adequate education. Therefore, I will ensure that he/she is in attendance, unless it is for an excusable reason as listed by the Decatur City School regulations, or approved beforehand by the office.
- 9. I furthermore am aware that the school hours are 8:00-3:00 pm and will therefore see that my child is there and prepared by the first bell. I realize that by 8:01 they are considered "tardy," and that every 5 tardies is recorded as an absence for all students regardless of the reason.
- 10. Absences accumulate for the year, whether excused or not. A student is in danger of failing an individual course or a whole grade for 10 absences per semester or 20 per year.
- 11. I understand that the school reserves the right to dismiss my child who fails to comply with the established regulations and discipline, or whose financial obligations remain unpaid.
- 12. I understand the requirement that my child must be in attendance at the church of their choice at least one time per week (twice per week if holding any leadership position) for grades 7 12. Therefore, I will ensure that this requirement is maintained throughout enrollment.

- 13. In the event that my child participates in any extra-curricular activities, I will cooperate with the coach or sponsor regardless of the manner in which he/she operates, the amount of time played, or the position played. In the event of losses I will not condemn the coaching personnel before other students, parents, or staff. If I cannot agree, I will quietly withdraw my child from the team/squad.
- 14. If my child is a senior I promise to reserve the dates for the WILDS trip for him/her to ensure our participation. I will cover our part of the cost, or see that it is covered through other methods.
- 15. I understand that it is very beneficial and essential for college entrance for my student to take the ACT, and thus guarantee to have him/her take it by the end of his/her senior year.
- 16. I realize that attendance at Cornerstone Christian School is a privilege granted my child(ren) by the membership of Cornerstone Baptist Church. Although regulations and standards may not be my own, I will abide by and respect them as long as my child(ren) is/are enrolled at CCS. Included in this is the understanding that I will not bring into this ministry, nor allow my childr(ren) to bring into this ministry anything contrary to those regulations, standards, and goals for which this Institution was established, whether it be physically or by attitude or speech. In the event that I can no longer abide by this agreement, or support this ministry, I will withdraw my child(ren) from CCS.
- 17. I have read and understand the "Acceptable Use Policy" concerning all social media. I do agree to abide by its regulations and will see that my child(ren) also conform as long as he/she is enrolled at CCS.
