Tuition Discounts

- Families with more than three children enrolled will receive free tuition for all other children enrolled. This discount does not include extended care, if offered.
- Full-time Pastors receive a 50% discount on tuition for all children enrolled. A form must be submitted yearly for approval of this discount.
- These discounts only apply to tuition. No fees will be discounted.

Payment Schedule

Ten Month Plan

Payments are due by the 5th of each month beginning in August and continuing through May. A late fee of \$10 will be added to all accounts not paid by the fifth of the month unless other arrangements have been made. If after 45 days the account is not up to date, it may be necessary to terminate the student's enrollment. Tuition will be prorated by the month if a student is only enrolled for a part of the school year. For students who withdraw, payment is due for the full month for which they withdraw.

Full Year Plan

If the full tuition is paid at the beginning of the year a 5% discount will be given. Should a student leave Cornerstone for any reason after having paid for the entire year, a refund will be given for any overpayment.

Explanation of Fees

A \$20 fee will be charged to accounts for a check returned by the bank unpaid. If as many as two checks are returned Cornerstone will accept no more personal checks from the student or patron. All report cards and/or transcripts will be held at the end of the school year until all financial or material obligations have been met. These fees are charged because of upkeep of equipment and use of materials. Registration and book fees are charged each year to every student. These are due upon enrollment and are non-refundable. Registration fees cover various tests, ACEA fees, insurance, etc. The Book fee covers all necessary textbooks and supplies that will be used by the student and include both non-consumable and consumable books. The students do not purchase their books by paying the Book fee. For textbooks that are lost or returned in an abused condition, the student will be charged the wholesale price to replace that textbook. Fees relating to participation, such as sports, are non-refundable if the student is put off the team/squad due to behavior or academics. Fees for sports related activities are due at the beginning of participation for a particular activity. However, only one sports fee will be charged per student per year. The graduation fee includes the cost of the diploma and cap and gown rental or purchase. This fee is due by the last tuition payment.

Financial Policy

CCS operates on a zero-profit basis for the purpose of making Christian education available to as many families as possible. Therefore, it is imperative that all accounts be paid on time. Cornerstone receives no Government funding or assistance from the State and depends upon regular income to meet the salaries of the faculty and staff and the operating expenses.
